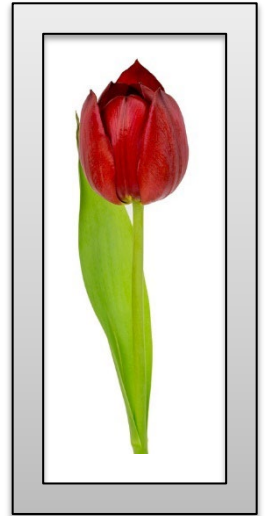

TOPIC: Flood Zone

How to get your Property Out of a Flood Zone



Speaker: **Karol L. Grove**

A graduate of Michigan Technological University (MTU), Karol Grove has been working as a licensed professional surveyor for over 25 years. Since 1995, she is the owner of Alpine Land Surveying Inc. located in Hartland, Michigan. Karol has served 22 years on the State of Michigan Professional Surveyors Board, where she currently serves as director. She is also the past chair of the State of Michigan Licensing Board for Surveyors, where she served 8 years on both the Surveyors and Engineers Licensing Boards. Active at the National Level, she is an Emeritus Member of the National Council of Examiners for Engineering and Surveying (NCEES), where she has served 2 terms on the National

Committee of Exam for Professional Surveyors (EPS) Committee and a subject matter expert for the national surveyor's exam for the past 10 years. She has been very active with the start-up and is chairing the TwiST Program in Michigan -- now in two locations: Ferris and MTU. Additionally, she serves on the Ferris State University Advisory Board, as well as the national committee called the Future of Surveying. Karol is a sought-after speaker/expert in Michigan and nationally on the topic of FEMA and Flood Zones.
